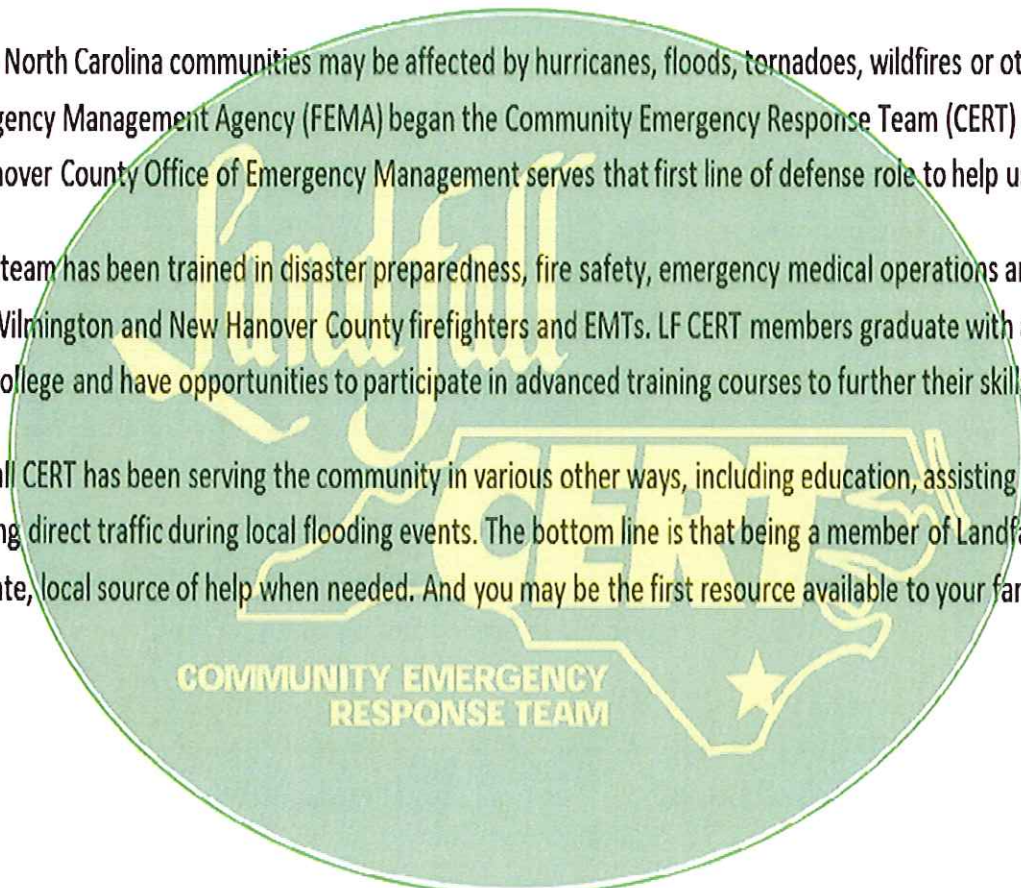


What is CERT and How Does Landfall CERT Work?

At any given time, North Carolina communities may be affected by hurricanes, floods, tornadoes, wildfires or other damaging events. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) began the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) concept in 1994. In our area, New Hanover County Office of Emergency Management serves that first line of defense role to help us in time of need.

Our Landfall CERT team has been trained in disaster preparedness, fire safety, emergency medical operations and light search and rescue taught by Wilmington and New Hanover County firefighters and EMTs. LF CERT members graduate with a certificate from Cape Fear Community College and have opportunities to participate in advanced training courses to further their skills.

Since 2007, Landfall CERT has been serving the community in various other ways, including education, assisting in the search for lost children and helping direct traffic during local flooding events. The bottom line is that being a member of Landfall CERT means you can be an immediate, local source of help when needed. And you may be the first resource available to your family and your neighbors.
